Woodlands By-Laws Addendum #1:

The following paragraph is added to the end of Section 4: Notice of Meetings

E-mail may be used as the primary method for delivering meeting notices. It is the responsibility of each Member to provide (and keep current) a valid e-mail address to the Board of Directors. If a Member does not have or does not provide a valid e-mail address, then that Member must provide a statement in writing to the Board that he/she does not have a usable e-mail address and must provide a specific postal address for receipt of notifications. If a Member does not provide to the Board either a valid e-mail address or a written statement as afore mentioned, then that Member waives his/her rights to object to lack of proper notice of a meeting.

Also, the following paragraph is added to the end of Section 7: Voting

E-mail may be used as the primary method for delivering ballots for referenda. It is the responsibility of each Member to provide either a valid e-mail address or a written statement of no usable e-mail address to the Board of Directors as required in Section 4, Notice of Meetings; otherwise that Member waives his/her rights to object to lack of proper notification of a referendum.
